



## NATIONAL GUARD CHAPTER EDUCATION PROGRAM



### Objective

The objectives of the ASMC National Guard Chapter Education Program are to recognize Chapter Members and their dependents for academic achievement and provide financial assistance that they may accomplish their future financial management educational goals through a college or university.

### Criteria & Submission

Member Criteria :

- Must be an Active Member for 24 Months
- Must be currently enrolled in a degree Plan that includes a Finance related study ( Business Administration, Economics, Financial Management, Accounting, Finance, or Auditing)
- Must have a GPA of 2.75 or higher
- Include copy of transcripts (may be unofficial copy)

Dependent Criteria:

- Must be an directly related to an Active NG Chapter Member for 24 Months
- Must be currently enrolled in a college Baccalaureate degree Plan that includes a Finance related study ( Business Administration, Economics, Financial Management, Accounting, Finance, or Auditing)
- Must have a GPA of 2.75 or higher
- Must have 2 letters of Recommendation
  - o High School Principle
  - o Academic Dean
  - o Guidance Counselor
  - o High School Teacher
- Include copy of transcripts or approved college academic plan ( may be unofficial copy)

### Selection Procedures

Applicant's scholastic achievements, leadership ability, extracurricular activities, career goals and financial need are considered for selection. A selection panel, including the ASMC National Guard Chapter Education Chair, review all applications and make the final recommendation to the Chapter Executive Committee to approve the final award winners.

### **Recognition**

Due to school tuition increasing the Chapter re-evaluated the cost of education.

The board voted to increase the scholarship & grant totals to \$3,000 and \$2,000.

The NG – ASMC Chapter will award dependent scholarships and/or member grants based on applicant criteria and selection procedures.

Recipients of these scholarships are notified via email upon selection.

Award recognition will be presented during the scheduled training event hosted by the Financial Community, May 2017 in Norman, Oklahoma.

The award presentations and names of recipients are published in newsletters and on the Chapter's website.
